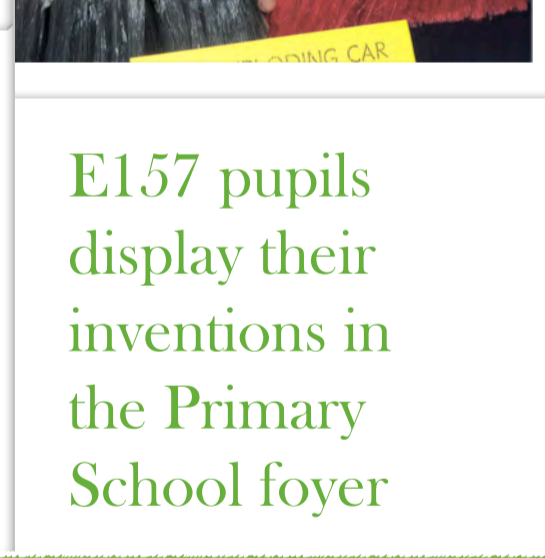




KIDS ARE INVENTORS, TOO!
